



Regular Board Meeting Minutes May 8, 2023 – 7:30 p.m.

Meeting called to order by Supv. Brian Moore followed by the Pledge of Allegiance In attendance: Brian Moore, Kimberly Jones, Penny Nelson. Absent: Keith Moore, Judy Wheelock Additions or corrections to the agenda. B. Moore: Cap's Pumping under old business.

With the one addition to the agenda, motion by K. Jones; 2nd B. Moore to approve the agenda as amended. Carried.

Motion by B. Moore; 2nd K. Jones to approve the April 10, 2023 minutes. Carried.

<u>Treasurer's report</u>. Treasurer presented the balance sheet along with the revenue and expenditure report. Two certificates of deposit are maturing and will be renewed at a new interest rate of 4.5%. Motion by B. Moore; 2nd P. Nelson to pay all bills using checks #9173 through 9194, and renewing the two certificates of deposit at 4.5%. Carried.

Fire department report. None.

<u>Blight Enforcement Officer</u>. Kenneth Millard found a grant that may help with cleanup. Explained the status of three outstanding violations. Will soon begin the process of placing the cost of cleanup as a lien, working with the township attorney on the exact procedure. Vondra Road has a lot of complaints and he'll begin the process of notification for these. Asked that Blight Enforcement be added to the annual newsletter.

<u>Campground Host</u>. Lisa Cypert had two downstate campers already. Lots of tree removal and a "widowmaker" on lot 10. B. Moore to contact a tree removal service. Part of the playground border was "smooshed". Could have been damaged during the winter rescue. Gates were damaged too.

New business.

- o BARC's clean-up day pricing distributed to board; same as last year.
- Motion by B. Moore; 2nd K. Jones to participate in the 2023 Hazardous Waste cleanup and sign said contract for \$339.60. Carried.

Old business.

- Cemetery rules review. Tabled until after B. Moore and Andy Saarm attend the June 20th MTA cemetery workshop in Gaylord.
- o Caps Pumping. Upset that we are not using his service anymore. Disputed billing question tabled.
