Kurick Rd. property: starting to pull stuff out of the pole barn. Haven't received an opinion on how to go further with liens. House on Healy Lake Rd is being torn apart.

<u>Campground Host</u>. Lisa Cypert said that Jeff fixed beach bench and regraded the lead-in road. K. Moore asked about having it brined and will contact Mark Sohlgen about that. Remarked that the unofficial campground across the lake was full of junk and garbage. P. Nelson to contact Doug Berry, campground supervisor, about the problem. Asked about having "widowmaker" branches removed. Still there. Need to bring in another tree removal service.

New business.

- Attorney recommendation on placing lien on property. Still pending.

Old business.

- Commitment of remainder of ARPA funds. Motion by K. Moore; 2nd P. Nelson to use the \$3215.44 remaining of the ARPA funds for tree removal in the cemetery. Carried.
